GENERAL INFORMATION

The Scientific Program Committee for the 2019 Annual Meeting of the California Society of Plastic Surgeons, Inc. (CSPS), invites the submission of abstracts for possible inclusion in the program.

The CSPS Scientific Program Committee will review all abstracts submitted and determine the category and time allotted for all papers submitted. Papers selected for presentation will be from 3-5 minutes in length. Papers selected will either be selected for presentation during the General Session or the Clinical Pearls & Peanuts Session.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSIONS ARE LIMITED TO 500 WORDS

For the Resident(s) submitting paper(s), please indicate on the Abstract Submission form (online) if you wish for your paper to be considered for the Resident Competition. Please note: To be considered as a Resident Competition Paper—Program Directors must certify the work submitted was performed by the Resident of an ACGME California Plastic Surgery Residency Program. The number of Resident Competition abstracts accepted from each training program will be limited to one per resident. As such, if you are Resident submitting multiple papers, please only indicate the one (1) paper you wish to be considered for the Resident Competition by indicating on the Abstract Form. All other paper submissions from Residents will be considered by the Committee for presentation.

NEW FOR THIS YEAR

The *ANNALS OF PLASTIC SURGERY* - We are pleased to announce our continued relationship between the *Annals of Plastic Surgery* and the CSPS.

The 69th CSPS Annual Meeting will provide presenters who have had their abstract(s) approved for presentation the opportunity to have their *abstract(s)* published in CSPS April 2019 Supplement of the *Annals of Plastic Surgery* [Note: Published in Abstract form only].

In addition, for those who present at the 2019 Annual Meeting, you will also have the opportunity to submit your manuscript for the CSPS May 2020 *Supplement of the Annals of Plastic Surgery*.

The manuscripts will undergo peer review by the CSPS Scientific Committee, revisions based on the often-lively discussions following each presentation as well as additional review by the Committee. These manuscripts will then be directed toward publication with an executive editorial review and copyediting.

The deadline for online submission of the manuscript to CSPS Supplement to the *Annals of Plastic Surgery* is:

July 1, 2019

Submission for publication is not required for presentation of an Abstract. Presenters may choose to submit their work to other journals or choose not to publish at all. Please indicate on the Abstract Submission Form (online) your interest to submit your abstract or and/or manuscript.

1. All persons who present an accepted paper must complete a faculty disclosure statement, submit their talk prior to the meeting, and register for the Annual Meeting and pay all applicable fees.
2. Resident Competition abstracts must be accompanied by a letter from the Residency Program Director certifying the work was performed by the Resident while in a California clinical plastic surgery residency program.
3. All abstracts submitted are limited to 500 words and should contain:
 - A. Introduction (including the objectives and the relevance)
 - B. Methods
 - C. Results
 - D. Conclusions

Abstracts will be evaluated in part on whether all of the above information is included. An important factor in judging clinical studies will be the length of follow-up documented in the abstract.

The CSPS expects that all of its CME program will adhere to the ACCME's content validation value statements. Specifically, all the recommendations involving clinical medicine in a CME activity must be based on evidence that is accepted within the profession of medicine as adequate justification for their indications and contraindications in the care of patients. All scientific research referred to, reported or used in CME in support or justification of a patient care recommendation must conform to the generally accepted standards of experimental design, data collection and analysis. Please contact the CSPS if you do not feel your abstract can meet these standards.

4. Once your abstract form is submitted and processed, a confirmation of receipt will be emailed to you.
5. Please address all questions or concerns to the 2019 Scientific Program Committee Co-Chairs. You will be notified of the acceptance or rejection of your paper by January 2019.
